

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Textbook: Required Textbook & Workbook: *Modern Greek*, by Theodore Papaloizos (8th Edition)

BEGINNERS A

This is a beginning level language course which presupposes no background in Greek. It will introduce the basics of the Greek language (starting with the Greek alphabet, then simple reading, listening, and writing) and culture. This course provides a general instructional approach to learning Greek.

BEGINNERS B

This course is a continuation of Beginners A. Students are expected to have some knowledge of some basic grammar, verb conjugations in the present form and vocabulary. This course provides a general instructional approach to learning Greek.

INTERMEDIATE 1A, 1B, 2A, 2B,

During these 4 semesters students strengthen tense understanding verbally and written, sentence structure and practice more speaking, reading/writing exercises.

ADVANCED

Students have taken courses or are deeply knowledgeable in the language and can read, write, and speak at a high level/near native. Students delve further into writing, speaking, reading and grammar.
